
>> I went to Cleveland in 2016 for the Republican National Convention with a group of cartoonists. I decided to take my Captain America persona with a few punchy banners.

# LIGHT OF SIKHI








# SIKH ROAD SIGNS







^ 1984 marks one of the most poignant and tragic years in the young 550 year Sikh history. The first week of June saw the Indian state and its security apparatus use its military to attack dozens of Sikh places of worship in Punjab as a response to a political struggle. The first week of November following the assassination of the Indian Prime Minister Indira Gandhi by her two Sikh bodyguards was witness to a Pogrom across cities in the nation. Tens of thousands of Sikhs perished in June and November. Justice was never served and 1984 serves as a turning point in Sikh psyche.


